VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE DETAILS

WELCOME BACK BBQ

The BBQ is an opportunity for new parents to meet others and to reconnect after the summer break. Volunteers are needed for setup, take down/clean up and barbecuing.

Time Commitment: 30 minute shift, one evening in September

COURTYARD ENHANCEMENT

Chinook Park School has a beautifully landscaped internal courtyard. Volunteers are required for maintenance and continued enhancement of the courtyard space on an ongoing basis.

Time Commitment: Flexible, as needed.

TRAFFIC

Volunteers are required to stand by the entrance of the staff parking lot to discourage u-turns in the parking lot as well as address other traffic concerns in collaboration with the school constable.

Time Commitment: Rotating mornings until ~8:15am or flexible.

SCHOLASTIC BOOK SALE

Volunteers are required for set-up/take-down and to work the cash desk and sell books to the children. The time commitment is flexible and the shifts are 2-3 hours in length. Both school hour and evening shifts available. This is an important fundraiser for books in the classroom.

Time Commitment: 2-3 hours over 4 days during fall parent/teacher conferences

FUN FOOD DAYS

Students get a Fun Food day approximately once a month. Volunteers are required to pass out pre-ordered lunches in the classrooms.

Time Commitment: 1-3 hours/month

BROWN BAGGING 4 CALGARY'S KIDS

Brown Bag Lunch (BB4CK) works in partnership with Calgary schools to provide healthy lunches for students who would otherwise go hungry. Volunteers for this program are required to shop for groceries and prepare snacks once a week. Shopping and preparation for the week needs to be done for Monday morning.

Time Commitment: 2 hours/week generally for 1 month of the school year. Schedule is flexible.

JACKET RACKET

This is a CBE/Catholic School Boards based program to provide winter jackets and snow gear to students in need throughout the city. Volunteers are required to collect donations at the school and drop off the donations to the Jacket Racket office.

Time Commitment: Flexible, 1-2 hours in October/November

LIBRARY

Duties include checking books in and out, shelving books, special projects and anything else as required.

Time Commitment: 1 morning or afternoon per month

KEY COMMUNICATOR

The Key Communicator attends CBE "Council of School Councils" meetings ~4 times per year along with members of the Board of Trustees and CBE Administration. This role will help you stay connected with what is happening at the CBE level. Meetings are held weeknights (6:30pm-8:30pm) at the CBE downtown.

Time Commitment: ~4 meetings/year

LA COMMITTEE D'ESPRIT FRANCAIS (FRENCH WEEK)

Volunteers are required to work with the teachers to organize and implement French Spirit Week (within the school) and Winter Carnival. Note: you don't need to speak French.

Time Commitment: Half a day in February

CHEQUE WRITING CAMPAIGN

Chinook Park School runs a Cheque Writing Campaign in place of selling products (like coupon books and chocolates) to raise funds for the school. Working with the coordinator, volunteers are required to collect cheques and promote the Cheque Writing Campaign at school events.

Time Commitment: Flexible, generally 1-2 hours at school events

FAMILY DANCE

Held at school, the family dance is an opportunity for students, parents and siblings to enjoy some music, food, and of course a lot of dancing. In order for the dances to run smoothly, we ask for parent volunteers to work short shifts. It's a great way to meet other parents. Stay tuned for details.

Time Commitment: ~30 mins, evening TBA

GRANTS COMMITTEE

This committee organizes and executes annual external grant applications for the fall, spring and summer funding cycles. Working with the leadership team at Chinook Park School, the Grants Committee team will search for external funding opportunities that suit our student's needs, and will write grant applications when appropriate. Volunteers with experience in grant writing, budgeting and researching are welcome!

Time Commitment: Flexible (throughout the year)

STAFF APPRECIATION LUNCH

This committee brings in food for a staff appreciation lunch to say thank you to the teachers, administration and support staff at the school. Volunteers are needed to provide a plate of food - no meetings or planning required.

Time Commitment: Flexible (at home), early June

SPORTS DAY

Sports Day is a super fun day filled with activities the kids enjoy. We are looking for parents that can spend the day supervising an activity station. We have anywhere from 25-35 stations to organize so please consider joining our team.
