 - b) In summary:
 - i) Council Balance \$34-\$35K
 - ii) Association Balance \$19.9K

- c) Expenditures - Expected vs Original Budget
 - i) Total: \$61.1K vs \$60.6K
 - ii) Council: \$21.5K expected vs \$31.0K originally budgeted *mostly due to the approval by AGLC to use Association funds to pay for Courtyard revitalization)
 - iii) Association: \$39.9K expected vs \$29.6K originally budgeted*
 - d) Revenues - Expected vs Original Budget
 - i) Total: \$17.3K expected vs \$25.1K originally budgeted *due in part to the lower ask for cheque writing, no family dance, fun foods lower
 - e) Continue to be no expectation for expenditures that fall outside of the scope of the originally approved budget
